HEALTH CHECKS

The school nurse team will be coming into school on 17 March 2015, to measure the height and weight of our Reception and Year 6 students. You would have received a permission form back in September last year. If you **DO NOT** give permission for your child to undergo these health checks, please contact the school office ASAP.

RUGBY CLUB

I am writing to inform you that our Monday night afterschool club has now changed from hockey to rugby. Qualified instructors from Kernow Sport and Leisure come in and run the sessions, and are hoping to gain some new members. The club is available to **all years**. This year we are able to subsidise the cost of the club, so there is no cost to parents. If your child is interested, please speak to the school office.

FOOTBALL CLUB (RECEPTION, YEAR 1, 2 AND 3)

We currently have qualified instructors from Kernow Sport and Leisure come into school and run a rugby club on Mondays afterschool. They are hoping to start up a football club for Reception – Year 3. It will be on a Monday

afterschool, alongside the rugby club. This year we are able to subsidise the cost of the club, so there is no cost to parents. If your child is interested, please speak to the school office.

FOREST SCHOOL

Unfortunately, due to the lack of students who have brought their kit in on the correct days, this year's forest school programme has been extremely disrupted. Therefore, it has been decided that **all** year 5 students **must** have their forest school kit with them **every Tuesday**. The students will then be spilt into a group on the day. We are extremely lucky to have Mrs Squire who is qualified to teach forest school, and a lot of time is put into the planning of the sessions. Therefore, it is imperative that students bring in suitable clothing and footwear to change into.

HEADLICE

Unfortunately, we are still observing head lice amongst our pupils. We urge **ALL PARENTS** to check your child(ren)'s head for any signs of head lice. If live lice are found, the wet combing method should be used **every 2-3 days for at least 2 weeks** (to break the life cycle of head lice) until the problem is cleared. All family members should be checked and treated if necessary. We suggest that checks should then continue to be made on a weekly basis to prevent any further infestations.

WE REALLY DO NEED EVERYONES PARENTS COOPERATION TO ERADICATE THIS PROBLEM.

SCHOOL DINNERS

As a school, we are charged for every dinner that a student has, unless the student is entitled to Free School Meals or Universal Free School Meals. Therefore, it is important that dinner money is received on time.

If your child is going to have a school dinner, can you please ensure that the money is brought in on the day, or in advance if preferred, so that we do not have to chase late dinner money.
