HEALTH CHECKS

The school nurse team will be coming into school on 17 March 2015, to measure the height and weight of our Reception and Year 6 students. You should have received a permission form back in September last year. If you **DO NOT** want to give permission for your child to undergo these health checks, please contact the school office ASAP.

HEADLICE

Unfortunately, we are still observing head lice amongst our pupils. We urge **ALL PARENTS** to check your child(ren)'s head for any signs of head lice. If live lice

are found, the wet combing method should be used <u>every 2-3 days for at least 2 weeks</u> (to break the life cycle of head lice) until the problem is cleared. All family members should be checked and treated if necessary. We suggest that checks should then continue to be made on a weekly basis to prevent any further infestations.
