Transport in the Past and in the Future	 In the past people used to travel in different ways. They would often use horses and carts. 	
	Early cars had to be wound up by hand.	
	 Some vehicles now are electric – which means they do not use petrol. More vehicles will be electric in the future. 	
	 In the future vehicles may be driverless.
