



## A Parent/Carer Guide to Remote Learning at Luxulyan School

## How will teachers set work and how can we help?

- ✓ Teachers will set themed weekly Rainbow Challenges on Class Dojo and the remote learning class pages on the school website, <u>click here.</u>
- ✓ You can find extra ideas for all areas of the curriculum on the school website under the COVID-19 tab, <u>click here</u>.
- ✓ We would like your child to complete an English, Maths and one other curriculum task each day.
- ✓ The expectation for primary pupils is 3 hours a day, on average, across the school cohort.
- ✓ You and /or your child need to upload photos of their remote learning each day on their Class Dojo
  Pupil Portfolio or in Tapestry Observations for Ash Class.
- ✓ Help them structure their day, have a place to work, and work without screen distractions.
- ✓ Are they stuck? Use any books they have at home, E-Books from Borrowbox, own research, or call on friends or the class team to help.
- ✓ Praise and celebrate their work, their resilience and their knowledge!

## How will teachers feedback work?

- ✓ Staff will approve and comment on remote learning uploaded in Class Dojo Pupil Portfolios, or Tapestry for Ash Class, each day.
- ✓ Not all tasks will need to be uploaded, just a selection of their learning from that day and, just like in the classroom, not all work will be marked.
- Feedback will be given either to the whole class feedback where the teacher reflects on next steps suitable to all; or individually using the comment function in the Pupil portfolio.
