Dear Parents/Carers,

The information below has been designed to help you to understand how we will support your child's education in the event that they are unable to attend school. This could be due to the COVID pandemic, symptoms or isolation.

Day One of Self-Isolation – (awaiting test results, isolating due to family member being positive)

On day one of your child not being in school, please use your child's login for Class Dojo and the internet to access a variety of websites for general work. On their Class Dojo page there will be activities for them to complete.

Here is a suggested timetable:

Maths	30-60 minutes	TT Rockstars or Numbots
English Writing	30-60 minutes	Choose an activity from the writing tasks uploaded on your Class Dojo page.
English Reading	30-60 minutes	Read your school reading book or read an online story using the researchify link - https://researchify.co.uk/ / Oak Academy / Oxford owl- https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/
Торіс	30-90 minutes	Pick an activity from your topic home learning document that will link to your topic in class.

Please see your Class Dojo page for updated tasks for your class.

All of this learning is instant and ready for your child to access so that there are no missed opportunities for learning. It also allows your child's teacher time to get up to date resources ready that are in line with the learning taking place in the classroom. These will be available from day two onward (please see table on next page).

Day 2 Onwards

English – tasks uploaded to Class Dojo following the sequence of learning happening in the classroom. The quantity will be dependent on age/year of your child. Some/all of these must be 'handed in' to your child's class teacher via the portfolio section for marking. English tasks will consist of Reading, Writing, and Spelling and Grammar activities in line with the class timetable. Phonics for EYFS and KS1 will be set by the class teacher focusing on previously learnt sounds. Links to appropriate RWI YouTube videos will be shared. Topic task(s) following the lessons being covered in class that week. These will be a combination of topic tasks and the Government's 'Oak Academy' lessons. These will be set by the teacher on the Class Dojo home page. These must be 'handed in' to your child's class teacher via the portfolio section on Class Dojo for feedback.

	Feedback will be more bespoke to individuals to identify any misconceptions and address these.
	End of week assemblies - delivered by Mr Gynn and/or Mrs Williams to keep in touch with the children, celebrate learning and help boost children's morale.

Please note, if your child is unwell with Covid symptoms we would not expect them to submit work until they feel well enough to. Please keep in contact with your child's teacher each day to let them know how they are getting on.

We understand this is a lot of information to process. We are sharing this with you so that you are prepared and aware of what we have in place for your child if they need access to remote learning. This will be different to how we worked during lockdown as there is the expectation that children will be in daily contact with their class teacher and will submit work for the teacher to see. This will all be done via Class Dojo.
