Expanded noun phrases lesson link	Solving a technology problem – research I want you to think about a new invention. It could be a change to an existing object or product or something completely new. Is there something that you find annoying such as getting the last bit of tomato ketchup out of the bottle? Watch the invention film and then write up to 3 problems and a possible solution for each. What is an invention? - Film link	Instruction writing - draft Today you will choose your favourite technology solution from yesterday. I would like you to write a set of instructions as to how to use it . It should contain a title, what you need, a sentence to describe the problem it is solving and about 10 steps with a concluding sentence. Instruction writing - Film link	Instruction writing – final version Today you will use your draft from yesterday to write your final version of your instructions. You will need to use some expanded noun phrases (Monday's lesson) and include a diagram too . Think about 'bossy verbs', language that moves the instructions forward such as next, afterwards and clear and tidy presentation. Have a look at the example HERE BE DRAGONS FOR IDEAS.
