Wrap Around Care Options



We are very happy to announce that Luxulyan school now offer wraparound care from 8:00-8:40am through our Sunrise club and after school care until 5:15pm through our Treetops offer.

Both clubs cost £4.00 per session with Sunrise club offering a light breakfast option of items such as toast, cereal, fruit and juice and Treetops also charging £4.00 per hourly session. Choose from 3:15-4:15pm or 4:15pm to 5:15pm or even both sessions. Treetops offer a light snack choice.

We are taking monthly bookings payable in advance on Parentpay please. Cut off time to book is THURSDAY 5PM for the following week.


Please could you let us know at least 48 hours prior to your booking if you have to cancel. Uncancelled bookings may still be charged as we will have to organise our staffing in advance.

Uniform is very important and we expect all parents to support our policy – all pupils are required to wear school uniform. Our School colours are forest green and yellow. The uniform consists of:

- A forest green school jumper, cardigan or fleece embroidered with the Luxulyan School logo is preferable. Round neck—not V Neck please. This is a required all year round.
- Grey school trousers, formal shorts, skirts or pinafores. This is a required all year round.
- White shirts/blouses or polo shirts (long or short sleeved) but not T-shirts. This is a required all year round.
- For summer, children may wear checked/striped green and white dresses.
- School shoes need to be black. Trainers are not to be worn, except for PE. Sandals can be worn in the warmer weather – but not ‘flip flop’ types, ‘Reefs’ or ‘Crocs’ as they are not suitable for the school environment.
- For PE children will require a green T-shirt, black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms and plimsolls/trainers.
- A PE bag will also be required which can be of any colour (this makes it easier for the children, especially the younger ones, to recognise their own bag)
- All uniform should be named.
- Please note: tight skirts, leggings, long baggy trousers, shoes with high heels or fashion sandals are not suitable.

Hair: In the interests of safety, practicality and hygiene, long hair, i.e. shoulder length or longer, should be tied back during the school day. This is particularly important during PE and swimming. Grade 1 haircuts are not acceptable and Grade 2 haircuts should be applied with caution. Pupils should not have their hair or eyebrows shaved. Therefore, styles such as tramlines patterns, mohicans are not allowed. Pupils should not have highlights or dyed hair.

Jewellery: Pupils should not wear jewellery to school. Stud earrings are acceptable.

Nail polish: Pupils should not wear nail polish to school.



School Lunches & Payments

School Lunches

School lunches are cooked on site by our cook Ms Truscott from Chartwells. There is a nutritious, healthy menu which always includes a vegetarian option. An example menu is in this pack.

Children in Reception (EYFS), Year 1 and 2 (KS1) are entitled to universal free school meals. Parents of Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 (KS2) children are asked to pay for their school dinners in advance on ParentPay. A school dinner costs £2.65.

The term's menus are sent out to parents/carers in advance and are also available from the school office. If your child brings a packed lunch we encourage this to be as healthy as possible.

Children may also be entitled to free school meals under the government pupil premium. If you think you may be eligible please feel free to contact Mrs Grubb in the school office who is always happy to help. We encourage all families who think they may be eligible to contact: The School Meals team, Cornwall Council West 3, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro TR1 3AY. Free School Meals can be applied for from when your child starts in Reception.



In an attempt to reduce cash and cheques in school we use ParentPay - a convenient, secure, online way to pay for trips, school dinners, swimming... You will be sent a account login when your child is registered at our school.

What does ParentPay do?

- offers a highly secure payment site.
- gives you a history of all the payments you have made.
- allows you to create a single account login across all your children that attend a ParentPay school.
- shows you all items available for payment relevant to each of your children.
- emails a receipt of your payment to the email address you register.
- offers you the ability to set automated email/SMS payment reminders.

How does ParentPay help you?

- gives you the freedom to make payments to school 24 hours a day 7 days a week.
- stops you having to write cheques or search for cash to send to school.
- gives you peace of mind that your payment has been made safely and securely.
- helps with budgeting; payments are immediate, there is no waiting for cheques to clear .
- payments for many of the larger trips can be made by instalments up to the due date.
- ParentPay is quick and easy to use.

Trips and Residential Visits

Exciting off site education experiences form a memorable part of your child's education and we plan trips to support our topics as often as we can.
