Deadline for SEND Transport Applications – Cornwall Council

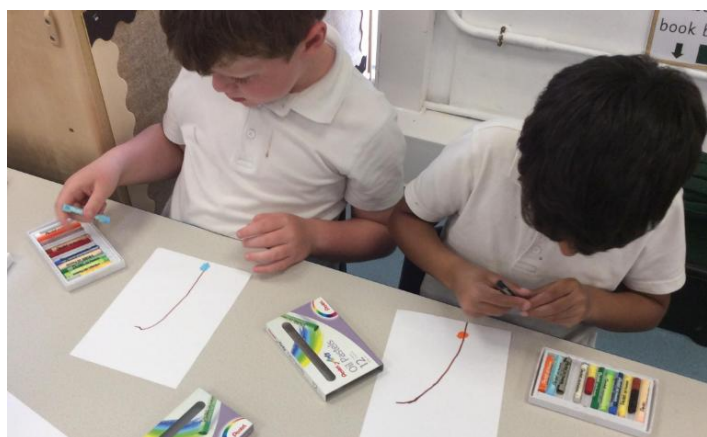
