Fundraising Update - fund a teacher for 1 day per week and also keep our wraparound care going!

**We received an incredibly generous donation of £500 from the Thursday Charity Coffee Mornings held at the Kings Arms in Luxulyan. We would like to say a huge thank you to everyone who participated and chose us as a beneficiary.**

As you are aware we are currently attempting to raise some additional funds for the school due to the very challenging financial position schools across the country are finding themselves facing.

You will have recently seen the school structure for 2024/25. After a lot of behind the scenes work I am pleased to be able to confirm that we have not had to let any of our teaching and support staff go.

We have had to reduce our teaching capacity by the equivalent of 2 days of a teacher per week however. This additional teaching capacity is used to support our Early Careers Teachers and also allows for much needed Senior Leadership time.

Therefore, we are going to simplify our message. We want to raise at least £10,000 to recruit a teacher for at least 1 day per week. Secondly, we would like to continue to provide an after school wraparound care facility. This is currently running at a loss and is therefore vulnerable. We would like to raise at least £3000 to continue with that provision.

Our ultimate goal will still be to get as close to £25,000 as possible for the many reasons highlighted in previous messages and updates.

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Local businesses have been very supportive and would like to support us further but, understandably, they want to see how much our school community is willing to assist before committing further funds.

I know it is a lot to ask in challenging financial times but if you can support us please visit our Just Giving page.
