Penalty Notices in Relation to Non-School Attendance

The law states that a **planned absence** from school should only be authorised for pupils in 'exceptional circumstances'. Here at Luxulyan School we recognise that there are occasions when it is appropriate to authorise an absence; we look at each request on its own merit, taking into account purpose, attendance history and study commitment.

I do appreciate the fact that the vast majority of our parents fully support their children's regular attendance at school, and understand the important link between attendance and achievement. However, during the academic year 2017-18, we have many absence requests from parents - most of these have been unauthorised by the school as they were for holidays and, therefore, not considered 'exceptional circumstances'.

In order to try and reduce the amount of holiday requests we receive, we have grouped our INSET days for 2018-19 so that families can have a two week Autumn half term holiday at a time when costs may have reduced due to the time of the year. We informed parents of this in October 2017.

From September 2018, due to the huge increase in the amount of absence requests we now receive, we may request that the Local Authority issue penalty notices to parents who remove their children from school without authorisation.
