Celebrations



- Different people celebrate different things and have different traditions.
- People celebrate their birthday to remember the day they were born.
- Bonfire Night is on the 5th November. People celebrate with bonfires and fireworks.



- Remembrance Day is on the 11th November. We remember all the people who have died in wars.
 There is a time of silence at 11am.
- Diwali is the Hindu festival of light and Hanukkah is the Jewish festival of light.

Christmas



- Advent is a time of preparation for Christmas.
- Christmas takes place on the 25th December and is a Christian festival celebrating the birth of Jesus.
- A Nativity play tells the story of Jesus' birth.
