

How did we perform in 2019?

The information given below gives details of our performance indicators for end of EYFS, Year 1 Phonics Screening, end of KS1 and end of KS2.

Early Years Foundation Stage 2019

Part of the DfE National Indicator set in relation to Early Years Foundation Stage Profiles specifies that a child achieving a 'Good Level of Development' will achieve the expected level in all Prime Areas of Learning as well as in the Literacy and Mathematics Specific Areas of Learning.

End of Key Stage 2 (Year 6)

Since the methodology and increased challenge with end of year assessments at KS2, the outcomes are now reported as 'Working towards age expected standard; Working at the expected standard or Working at greater depth within the expected standard'. *Please note that the content, format and scoring of tests changed in 2016. Comparisons with previous results cannot be reliably made.*

This table shows the percentage of children at the end of KS2 (Year 6) who achieved the **expected standard or above** in reading, writing, GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling) and maths.

This table shows the **average scaled score** in the 2019 tests. A pupil's *raw score* in the test was converted to a *scaled score*. 80 is the lowest scaled score and 120 the highest. A pupil awarded 100 or more has met the expected standard.
