Wraparound Survey Results

What do I like about Sunrise?

- It enables me to drop off so I can get to work on time. I like that children get breakfast/snacks (in our case in addition to a breakfast at home too!
- The start time and the children enjoy it
- The staff, breakfast provided

What do I like about Treetops?

- Friendly staff, letting the children explore and play at their own pace in a relaxed environment
- Can be used last minute if a club is cancelled. Ability to book in advance. My daughter enjoys the snacks provided. Great option for working parents.
- Guaranteed care, my child is always enthusiastic about what he has been doing there
- The children enjoy it, they do crafts and get snacks. It enables me to use it alongside other after school clubs so I don't have to do 2 separate pick ups
- Thanks for your help and support with this, especially those staying on to run this

What would make it better?

- Its quite expensive as sometimes I drop off at 8.20 but I appreciate the cost and staffing etc
- Reduced price for siblings
- I do sometimes forget to book for the following week on a Thursday so the ability to book on the day if the staffing levels are adequate would be great.
- Always nice for it to be a bit cheaper but understand you need to cover costs. Maybe limit the snack amount as they are too full to eat their dinner.

Mrs Grubb has contacted Parentpay to see if there is a way that parents/carers can view their bookings. Unfortunately, we have been informed that this is not possible so you can contact Mrs Grubb or make a note yourselves which days/sessions you book.

We'll always take last minute bookings to help out if staffing levels allow. Please just contact Mrs Grubb and she can book for you, however, we are encouraging booking sessions yourself but appreciate, sometimes, short notice can't be helped.




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
Making bookings on Parent Pay

Luxulyan School would really appreciate your support in pre-booking your child's Sunrise and Treetops sessions, and also school lunches. We kindly ask that Sunrise and Treetops clubs are booked for the week ahead, by 12pm each Thursday; and school meals are booked by 7.30am daily. You can book a week, month or half term in advance.

- 1. Go to www.parentpay.com and log in.
- 2. Select the child to make bookings for [1].




3. From the menu [2] select Book meals and places > Make bookings [3].





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4. Select the **Event (Lunchtime/Sunrise Club/Treetops Club)** that you wish to make a booking for **[4]** and if required choose a week. Then select **Make or view bookings [5].**




5. A booking screen will be presented: Book a meal or event by clicking the day of the week it is required for. Use the **Next week** button to make further bookings.






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- 6. Make all desired bookings.
- 7. A summary will be displayed at the bottom of the page with any previous unpaid bookings shown in red.



WARNING: Any bookings must be confirmed and (if required) paid for within 2 hours of selecting them. Failure to do so will result in the bookings being automatically cancelled.

- 8. Review the booking summary and select confirm booking.
- 9. Any credit in your Parent Account will be used to pay for the meals. Any remaining cost can be paid by Bank Transfer (if enabled), Visa Checkout or Other payment method.
