# Covid Update

The new COVID-19 Operational Guidance for Schools published this week recommends that there is no longer the need to keep children and staff in consistent groups (bubbles) and whole school assemblies can resume. We will continue to ensure hand hygiene and that the classrooms are well ventilated with CO2 monitors.

The DfE recommends that face coverings are worn by staff and adults (including visitors) when moving around in corridors and in communal areas. (particularly at busy drop off and pick up times). Health advice continues to be that children in primary schools should not be asked to wear face coverings.

We will continue to notify you if there are positive COVID cases in your child's class. We will share with you, via email, all the information we legally can. We are unable to tell you whether the case is a staff member or child or when that person was last in school. The information does not require you to take action unless your child display symptoms, when you should be taking them for a PCR test and follow the most up to date guidelines.
