During the day, the children will have a guided tour of the site and take part in a workshop called 'Working Life for Me' where the children will get to handle museum artefacts, photos and costumes exploring working life in the Clay Country.

The children will be travelling to and from Wheal Martyn by minibus and will be returning before the end of the school day.

We have been very lucky to secure a grant from the Cornwall Heritage Trust towards transport costs.

We do, however, need to ask for a payment of £6.50 for each child to cover the cost of entry to Wheal Martyn and the workshop.

Children will need to bring the following:
