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#### <u>Attendance – CELT</u>

Cornwall Education Learning trust regards school good pupil attendance as the key factor in underpinning welfare and progress. Through trust's policy CELT schools are able to promote the importance of good attendance and challenge attendance issues and safeguards the rights of pupils to be educated.

Regular and punctual school attendance is important. Pupils need to attend school regularly if they are to take full advantage of the educational opportunities available to them by law. As a trust, CELT



recognises its responsibilities to ensure children are in school and on time, therefore having access to learning for the maximum number of days and hours.

Staff can promote attendance in a variety of ways, for instance, by maintaining appropriate registration processes, consistent and systematic daily records which give details of any absence and lateness following up absences and lateness if parents/carers have not communicated with the school.

Every school, by law, has to register pupils twice a day; first thing in the morning at the start of the school day and again in the afternoon session. Pupils must be present at both registration times to be given a present mark.

#### **Effects of Non-Attendance**

Any absence affects the pattern of a child's schooling and regular absence may seriously affect their learning. The Department of Education (DFE) defines a pupil/student as a 'persistent absentee' when they miss 10% or more schooling across the school year, for whatever reason. Pupils/students who miss 50% or more are defined as 'severely absent'.

The table below indicates how what might seem like just a few days of absence can result in children missing a significant number of lessons.

Attendance during the school year	Days lost in a year	Approximate number of weeks
95%	9.5 days	2 weeks
90%	19 days	4 weeks

CELT schools monitor trends and patterns of absence for all pupils/students as part of its standard procedures. However, it is recognised that absence from school may be indicators of abuse and neglect, including the exploitation of children. The Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) regularly liaise with members of school staff with responsibility for attendance to ensure risk is identified and appropriate intervention is in place to protect children from harm.

### **St Austell Music Festival**


Keslowena/Congratulations to our amazing choir for your performance at the St. Austell Music Festival. You were fantastic - we are all so proud of you.
