Late to School

A reminder that the school gate opens at 8.40am and closes at 8.50am. After this time your child will be registered as late or unauthorised absence due to lateness so please ensure that your child/ren arrive at school by 8.50am.

Being on time means that:

- Your child will have time to quickly catch up with friends before first lesson.
- Your child does not miss any work at the start of the lesson.
- Your child does not have to struggle to catch up with the lesson and/or join a group late that has already started working on a topic

Being late adds up to loss of learning:

- 5 minutes late every day adds up to 3 days lost each year
- 10 minutes adds up to 6 days lost each year

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- 15 minutes adds up to 10 days lost each year
- 20 minutes adds up to 13 days lost each year
- 30 minutes adds up to 19 days lost each year

Being on time means not missing out!

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Health advice from health visiting and school nursing teams



From Monday 15 January 2024, we have introduced a quick and easy way for young people and parents / carers to contact Health Visitors and School Nurses in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly.

There are three advice lines as follows:

- young people aged 11-19: **07312 263 096**
- parents / carers of children aged 0-5: **07312 263 423**
- parents / carers of children and young people aged 5-19: **07312 263 499**

Users can send a message, anonymously if they wish, to Health Visiting and School Nursing to get confidential help and advice about a range of health concerns, including:

- Sleep
- Child development
- Support with behaviour
- Toileting
- Feeding and nutrition
- Keeping safe and healthy
- Childhood illnesses and support with medical conditions at school
- Emotional, mental health and wellbeing
- Relationships
- Smoking and vaping
- Drugs and alcohol

The messaging service is available Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays) from 9am to 5pm. When a message is sent to the numbers, an automated reply confirms the message has been received. A trained healthcare professional will reply to the message during office hours within 48 hours.
