Well, the past couple of days have certainly been very warm indeed! Please continue to remember to send children in with sun cream and a hat so we can enjoy it all as safely as possible- thank you.

Some of you will have read my update on Dojo earlier in the week and I have included it in today's newsletter... A few parents have asked if the government's recent update regarding the 2m distancing rule changing to the '1m+' rule has any implications in schools. Currently we will await to hear any further decision/s from CELT if this will be the case for us, but as far as we are concerned Luxulyan's protocols, procedures and routines that we have put in place REMAIN THE SAME and will do until further notice. Please note that if your child is in either EYFS/Y1/Y6 and you have not contacted the school to request that they return by end of the day on Monday 6th July, we will assume that they will not be attending until the new academic year. This will allow staff to plan ahead for the last 2 weeks in school adequately before the summer break. This 'cut-off' date DOES NOT apply to the Key worker group however. Please continue to contact Mrs Grubb via the office to book this on a weekly basis.

Regarding the Y6's, a CELT-wide decision has been made for a secondary school teacher (from either Brannel, Penrice or Poltair) to come over to the Luxulyan to teach our Y6 'bubble' in the hall from wb. July 6th. This will not be transition in any way, more of a 'flavour of secondary' school.

This also releases Mrs Williams and Mr Heagney, so we are pleased to invite back our YEAR 5's into Oak Class on a Monday-Thursday 9:30am-2pm from Monday 6th July. Please email Mrs Grubb on secretary@luxulyansch.org by **Wednesday 1st July** to inform the school should you wish for your child to attend from the following week.

Please also note that - EYFS and Year 1 pupils will enter and exit the school via the GREEN METAL GATES now due to this change, the same staggered time slots will apply.


KEY WORKER REMINDER
