School Uniform Expectations

I would like to take the opportunity to refresh our uniform expectations. We are very proud of our forest green uniform, it instils a sense of pride and belonging to Luxulyan School and the wider community. I ask for your support in ensuring your child is wearing the correct items as the staff have begun to notice a variety of footwear and alternative items being worn to school. Our uniform can be purchased from Cornwall Screenprint and Asda.

I ask that children with longer hair tie it back it helps when taking part in active lessons and minimises the spread of head lice.

If anyone would like some support with this, please let us know.



- A forest green school jumper, cardigan or fleece embroidered with the Luxulyan School logo is preferable.
- Grey or black school trousers, formal shorts, skirts or pinafores.
- White shirts/blouses or polo shirts (long or short sleeved) but not T-shirts.
- For summer, children may wear checked/striped green and white dresses.
- School shoes need to be black. **Trainers are not to be worn**, except for PE. Sandals can be worn in the warmer weather – but not 'flip flop' types, 'Reefs' or 'Crocs' as they are not suitable for the school environment.
- For PE children will require a green T-shirt, black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms and plimsolls/trainers. A school sports hoodie is an optional extra.
