A 'HELLO' from the SENDCo!

Hello everyone. I wanted to take this opportunity to signpost you all to some information and updates...

In the first instance, if you have a concern about your child in school and their learning it is always best to contact the class teacher. They know your child well and so can discuss these concerns with you. If further advice /support is then needed - that's where I come in!

If your child already has a Special Educational Need and is on the Record of Need (RON) you will have meetings with their class teacher to discuss individual targets and support in school. These meetings should happen termly (3 times a year). If you haven't had a SEND meeting this term with a class teacher and feel you should have, please contact the school to discuss.

The school website, in the Inclusion section has all statutory SEND documents for you to refer to, should you wish to.

In future correspondence I will giving local SEND updates and signposting you to any useful links etc.
