Year 1 Hearing Screen Test

On Thursday 19th September, Jo Weymouth- from the Audiology department at Treliske Royal Cornwall Hospital will be visiting Luxulyan School to carry out a hearing screen test for our Year 1 children.

Hearing screening (Year 1)

Although we ask for permission in Reception, we aim to check the hearing of all children aged 5 - 6 years in Year 1.

The screening will take place in your child's school. Assessments are undertaken by a Paediatric Hearing Screener (specialist hearing health professional).

Why should your child be screened?

To help identify a child with a hearing problem, for example glue ear.

Results

You will receive a letter (sent home with your child) on the day of the test. This will say if your child's hearing is normal, or if the test indicates a possible problem. If required your child will be invited to a further test at a local hospital.

There are many reasons why we may be unable to obtain a "clear response" at the first hearing test, so if necessary a second test may be performed about 8 - 12 weeks later to allow any temporary problems to resolve.

Attendance Update

Attendance

August will see the changes to the National Penalty Notice Framework come into force. Specifically, the changes are:

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1. A new national threshold of 10 unauthorised sessions for any reason (equivalent to 5 school days) within a rolling 10 school week period for which a penalty notice must be considered. A penalty fine can be issued for any combination of unauthorised absences over a 10- week rolling period. They can be consecutive or non-consecutive and can span over two terms.

2. An increase in the penalty fine from $\pounds 60$ to $\pounds 80$ if paid in 21 days. If the fine is not paid by the first 21 days, it will rise to $\pounds 160$ if paid within 28 days of being issued.

3. If a 2nd penalty fine is issued to the same parent for the same child within a 3-year rolling period, the fine will automatically rise to ± 160 with no option to pay the lower rate of ± 80 .

4. If a parent then commits a third offence in a 3-year rolling period, the local authority will need to consider options available to them to improve attendance. This will include a consideration to prosecute under section 444 of the Education Act 1996.

5. The current penalty notice warning letter used for unauthorised absence (not holiday) will be changed to a Notice to Improve.

Impact of Lateness

We have started the year off well with excellent attendance and reducing lateness Every day counts.

Please remember that the gates open at 8.40am and shut at 8.50am.
