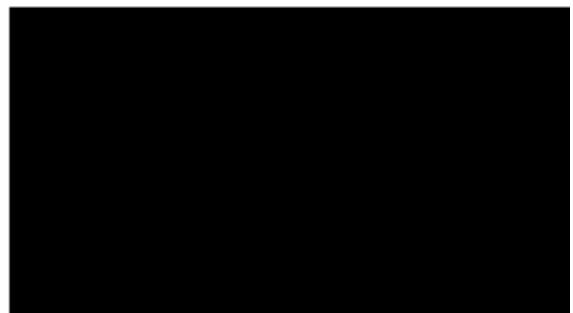
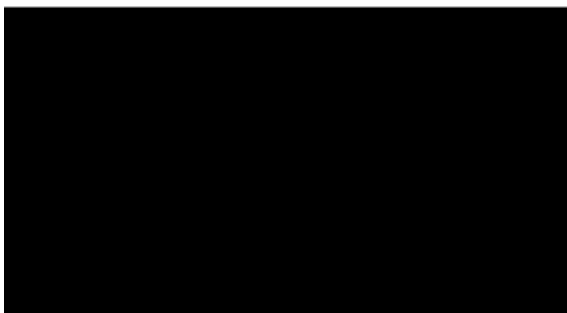
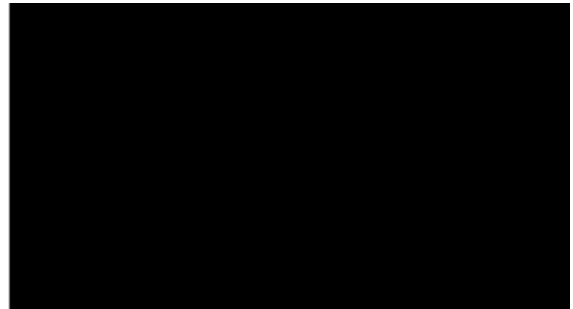
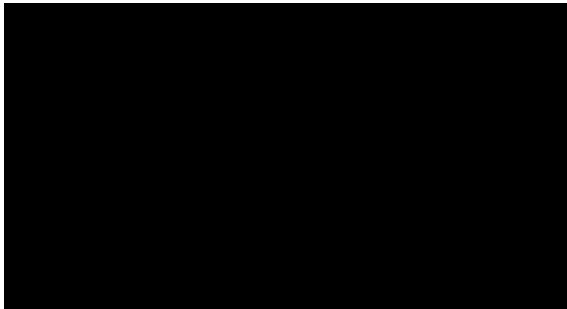
### **A message from Cornwall Heritage Trust**
