Dear Parent/Guardian

Your child's annual nasal flu vaccination is now due

Kernow Health's School Age Immunisation Service is delivering the nasal flu immunisation programme in Cornwali's and Devon's schools on behalf of NHS England & Improvement. Flu can be a very unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable friends and family by preventing the spread of flu.

In 2024/25 all children in Primary Schools from Reception to year 6 (inclusive) will be offered the vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for young children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose. Please enter <u>www.nhs.uk/child-flu</u> to access information explaining the vaccination programme which also includes details about the small number of children for whom the nasal vaccine is not appropriate. We are due to visit your child's school on Wednesday 13 November 2024. In order to access the online consent form, please enter or click on the following link: https://www.kernowimmunisations.co.uk/Forms/Flu PLEASE ENSURE YOU ENTER THE FULL UNIQUE SCHOOL REFERENCE CODE. The code for your child's school is: EE142712

Please submit your consent form by midday on Monday 11 November 2024 to ensure your child receives their vaccination. If you experience any problems accessing the form please telephone 01872 221105 for Cornwall schools and 01392 342678 for Devon schools and the team will be happy to help. Please note that as in previous years you must opt into the programme. If a consent form is not submitted your child will <u>not</u> be vaccinated.

If your child becomes wheezy or has their asthma medication increased after you submit this form, please contact us on the numbers above.

If you decide you do not want to vaccinate your child against flu, it will help us if you still complete and submit the consent form giving the reason. This will help us to plan and develop the service. Please tell us if you need this information in a different format.

You do not need to do anything if you are happy for your child to be screened.

Vision screening

Assessments are undertaken in your child's school by a screening professional from an orthoptic department.

Why should your child be screened?

To identify any problem with the vision, for example a need for glasses.

Results

You will receive a letter (sent home with your child) on the day of the test. This will say if your child's vision is normal or if the test indicates a possible problem. If required, your child will be invited for a further test at a local hospital.

Please note: Your child does not need to be screened if he/she is already receiving treatment from a local hospital or has already been seen by an Optician. Click here to withdraw your child from Vision Screening in School
