Assessments

We have reached the end of a busy week for our Year 6 children as they completed their End of Key Stage Two assessments. The national press coverage regarding these assessments has not gone unnoticed by staff, we regularly tell the children how challenging the expectations of the curriculum are and we could not have asked more of them this week. We have been so proud of how they have applied themselves to each and every paper, they are a credit to you demonstrating how capable, studious and resilient they truly are. Well done Year 6!

Thank you to every member of the school team who helped the week run smoothly: Year 5 and Mrs Berry who were displaced each morning to the School Hall; everyone who took turns running the breakfast club; all of the classes who kept the school calm and purposeful whilst the tests were in progress; all of the adults who supported the process; everyone at home who helped to reassure, revise and generally cheerlead them through the week.

It is worth noting that these assessments are the result of their complete Primary Education and at Luxulyan we take pride in the quality of education in every class. May and June are the months when other key assessments are carried out for our children in Year 1, 2 and 4.

Year 2 will be completing the Key Stage 1 assessments in reading and maths over the next two weeks, they will take them in the classroom with familiar adults and it will be much like any other day in school, just with a test to complete.

At the beginning of June, Year 1 will complete the Year 1 Phonics Screening assessment, thank you for your support at home with their sounds, they are all making phenomenal progress.

Year 4 will take the Multiplication Tables Check at the beginning of June, thank you for your support at home with practicing short sharp bursts of times table fact recall and playing soundcheck on Times Table Rockstars, they are making excellent progress with their knowledge.
