## **London 2022**

A visit to the capital city is always exciting and we plan to make the most of all the museums and sights that London has to offer including a tour and workshop activity at the House of Parliament.

**On the first day the children will need a packed lunch brought from home. This should be in a day bag with drinks (not fizzy).** They will also need £5 in a named sealed envelope to buy a snack at a service station on the way home.

We need to know of any dietary requirements at least four weeks before our trip. Please let us know if your child has any.

### **Kit List**

**Please do not bring anything that is valuable which could get damaged. Aerosol deodorants are also not allowed at the hostel as they can set off fire alarms. All items should be labelled. Thank you.**

**Mobile phones must not be taken.**

### **Clothing**

Take plenty of clothing in case of wet weather. The children will only need to wear school uniform for their visit to the Houses of Parliament. At all other times they can wear comfortable casual clothes.
