# CLASS DOJO

During this week you should have received details of your parent login for 'Class Dojo'. Some parents will already be familiar with this program as we have been using it successfully in Years 5 and 6 for some time.

Class Dojo is a method of communication between the class teacher and parents. Teachers are able to send reminders or notices via the Dojo messenger system. In Key Stage 2 teachers will award Dojo points to your child for good work or behaviour and you will be notified of this via the system. In Key Stage 1 a visual class based reward system will still be used. The program also allows parents to contact teachers and responses will be sent within two school days. However, if a more rapid response if required, parents must contact the School Office to speak to the teacher.

Please make sure that you use the code to access Class Dojo as we have found it incredibly useful to keep parents up to date with how their child is doing in school.

Please note that EYFS (Reception and Nursery) will use the Interactive Learning diary (ILD) to communicate with parents rather than Class Dojo. Parents will receive further information on ILD at the Meet The Teacher session.

### **ATTENDANCE**

Please note that, since September 2018, any unauthorised absence from school due to a holiday may be referred to the Cornwall Council who will issue a Penalty Notice. Parents were informed of this planned change to our Attendance Policy in September 2018 and we organised our INSET days to create a two week October half term in 2018 to encourage parents not to take their children out of school for holidays.

Our school attendance target is 96.3% and we regularly monitor attendance, writing to parents of those children whose attendance falls below 96% to see if there is any way we can help to improve this figure. Although 90% attendance may seem a high figure, this equates to 20 days of school missed over the course of a year, which is four school weeks. This can have a significantly detrimental impact on a child's progress at primary school.
