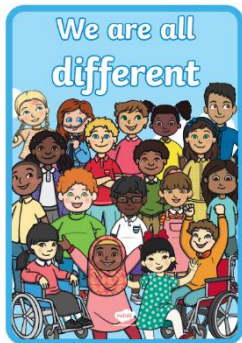

Key Vocabulary
