By this stage in their training BEd student teachers will have had previous school experience placements in a variety of settings and across Key Stages. Miss Searle will be closely mentored and supported by Mrs Williams and Mr Heagney in class as she is required to take increasing responsibility for the whole class teaching, over the course of the weeks. During this experience student teachers will fulfil all requirements of meeting the Teachers' Standards to a high level in order to reach the National Standards for QTS.
