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School Funding!

You may be aware that we have started fund raising for the next school year. I have been asked some further questions with some answers below:

- 1) Why are we fundraising? School budgets have been squeezed over the past 10 years to the extent that many school are facing budget deficits which in turn impacts upon the educational experience of pupils. We want to ensure that we continue to provide the best possible outcomes for the community. Your children deserve it!
- 2) Have any other schools done this sort of thing before? Yes, many schools fundraise but usually to support parent and carers groups such as PALS. Lerryn school have been fundraising for a teacher for the past 2 years.
- 3) Where will the money go? We will allocate the money into a variety of areas. Approximately 50 60% will go towards ensuring staffing levels can be maintained. This will allow us to maintain provisions such as targeted support for pupils who need additional help to access learning. Approximately 10 15% will go towards improvements to the school grounds facilities for sports such as netball posts and goalposts. We will also need to add to our football and netball kits for next season. Approximately 10% will go towards supporting trips such as our residentials to ensure that all pupils can access these extras. Around 5% will go towards supporting community projects and around 10% will assist with transport costs which are an increasingly high cost for schools.
- 4) Who is supporting us? We are engaging with the business community, parents, carers, and the local community.

Each week we will give you an update on our current fundraising levels.

Late to School

If your child is frequently late to school it means they are missing valuable learning time and is in danger of falling behind.

Being on time means that:

- Your child will have time to quickly catch up with friends before first lesson.
- \cdot Your child does not miss any work at the start of the lesson.

 \cdot Your child does not have to struggle to catch up with the lesson and/or join a group late that has already started working on a topic

Being late adds up to loss of learning:

- · 5 minutes late every day adds up to 3 days lost each year
- · 10 minutes adds up to 6 days lost each year
- 15 minutes adds up to 10 days lost each year
- · 20 minutes adds up to 13 days lost each year
- 30 minutes adds up to 19 days lost each year

Being on time means not missing out! Our school opening times are 8.40am – 8.50am. Any child coming to school after this time will be registered as late so please ensure your child is in school on time.
