## Holidays in Term Time - Changes to Policy and Penalty Notices

As you will be aware, Luxulyan school value the importance of attendance. We also know how hard you work to support the school in this area and how aware you are of the impact low attendance can have on your child's educational experience.

I would like to make you aware of some changes that have been announced by the Department for Education which could have an impact on you from September.

Firstly, a reminder that we are unable to authorise any holidays during term time. Holiday prices are inflated during school holidays as we know and of course school staff are also impacted by this. We are not able to use this price inflation as a reason to authorise term time holidays.

From September a new change is that if you take up to 10 school sessions, or in other words 5 days consecutively, you may be issued with a penalty notice immediately. This is a change from the current system.

We will always try to work with you wherever possible but the issue of holidays and their impact on attendance and education will continue to be a national focus.
