All equipment is provided at school.• If your child or any of your support bubble develop any symptoms or are unwell, please follow the advice on the Coronavirus Covid-19 website, inform us and keep your child off school until a negative test result is confirmed.• Be mindful of maintaining social distancing at the end of the day and leave as soon as you have collected your child/children. We realise that this is the most congested time of the day at school and we are grateful for your support.• Keep up to date by reading Class Dojo, School Newsletter and any emails.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children are taught in bubbles which do not mix: Ash and Beech Bubble, Sycamore Bubble and Oak Bubble.• Staggered breaktimes/lunchtimes• Ventilated classrooms• Increased hand washing/hand sanitising• Enhanced cleaning throughout the day• Drop off window between 8:30 and 8:45am• Using Class Dojo to provide home learning activities if your child has to self-isolate.• Use the outdoors as much as we can.• All activities in school are carefully considered and risk assessed.• Monitor the wellbeing of all of our staff and children when in school and anyone showing symptoms will be sent home to self-isolate and get a test.
