

School Bulletin Friday 12th July 2024

As we draw nearer to the end of term we are already very busy planning for September and beyond. Christmas shows, summer 2025 residentials and swimming for February 2025 are all booked at this stage of the year and we are receiving lots of enquiries from potential new pupils whilst also providing stay and play sessions for the new reception pupils. We are very keen to ensure that the last 2 weeks of term give opportunity to reflect upon the year that has passed in a positive and supportive manner.

Our school outcomes have been amazing this year, pupils and staff have all worked incredibly hard with the most recent results showing year 4 achieving an average score of 22/25 on their multiplication check with 53% achieving 25/25. In the early years we have 80% of pupils achieving the good level of development goal and 100% of our year 1 passing the phonics screening check. Year 2 also achieved high pass rates in their recent SATS and our year 6 achieved 73% combined (reading, writing and maths) against a projected national average of 61%.

Attendance levels currently put us as 3^{rd} place across all primary schools in Cornwall and in the top 10% of primary schools nationally.

What a hardworking, talented and amazing group of pupils we have here. Thanks so much for the support you provide us to ensure we can do our job effectively for the community.

Now let's hope that the England team can do the same this weekend!


