The end of another different, but fun week at Luxulyan School is here. Fingers crossed the weather is beginning to pick up again for next week at least!

September update-

Many of you will have heard in the news that there are no plans for children outside of the current EYFS, Y1 and Y6 to attend school until the new academic year in September. As we have to work within the most recent DfE guidelines with class sizes of no more than 15 we physically would not have enough space or indeed enough teachers to accommodate more year groups whilst also being committed to remaining open to pupils of key workers.

With this in mind please remember to continue to access the home learning that is available through Class Dojo. This is also your child's opportunity to have feedback and contact with their teacher. We have also provided paper copies of the home learning to a number of families as we appreciate that some may have no internet access or enough devices available in the home to be able to complete the home learning. If this is the case please contact Mrs Grubb on the secretary email address.

At the moment nobody knows what education will look like across the country in September and there has been a great deal of surmising and conjecture. As a school we will have to remain flexible to all possibilities, however we have made plans to be open to all pupils again on Wednesday 2nd September and we will adapt those plans as necessary, taking into account any updated guidance and guidelines that are set by the DfE.

Our aim is to welcome our new EYFS children into Ash class who will also be taught alongside a group of Year 1's (some of our current EYFS pupils). These Year 1's will be selected by the class teachers (and parents informed by the end of this term) Mrs Berry and Miss Illsley, as children who it is felt would further benefit from additional time in an EYFS/1 environment before gradually phasing into the Y1/2 class by the end of the academic year. The rest of Y1, together with Y2 will be taught in Beech class, Y3/4 will be taught in Sycamore and Y5/6 will carry out their learning in Oak class as in previous years.

There are currently no plans to move the teachers or teaching assistants in any class, apart from the fact that we now welcome Mr Nathan Cooper to teach Year 5/6 in Oak class during Mrs Hewins' maternity leave from September 1st.

I am sure you will understand that, all these plans are subject to change in these extraordinary times, but we will endeavour to keep you as informed as much as possible and as soon as we possibly can.

In the meantime please continue to access the learning that the teachers have set for for your child/ren on Class Dojo.

Can I just say thank you to the parents / carers who have sent emails and messages of gratitude and understanding to school staff during these 'new' and challenging times...

We are all in school because we care and it is 'what we love to do'. We always aim to give the pupils the very best experiences and these messages of thanks have been much appreciated!
