WELCOME BACK

Hope everyone had a lovely relaxing Easter holiday and are ready for the new Summer Term!

ASH CLASS

The children were very excited to return to School after the Easter holidays. They shared their experiences of exciting Easter egg hunts, sleep overs with friends and new additions to their families. As part of their 'Rainbow challenges,' they had to write about the Easter holidays which they shared with the rest of the class.

In Literacy, we have been using a story map and role-play activities to learn the story 'How to Catch a Star.'

In Maths, we have been learning about the days of the week and practising telling the time on analogue clocks.

During our child-initiated activity time, we have been busy modeling planets from playdough, building rockets to travel to the moon using junk modelling materials and community blocks and painting repeated patterns.

In preparation for warmer weather, please ensure your child brings in a bottle of water each day. It is also advisable they have sun cream labelled with their name, which we can keep in School.
