PARKING ON THE DOUBLE YELLOW LINES/ZIG ZAG LINES

Please can we ask parents/carers <u>again</u> to NOT to park on the double yellow zig zag lines outside of the school gates <u>at any time</u> of the day.

We have received another complaint from a member of the public and have contacted out local PCSO so they are aware of the situation.

The Highway Code states: "You MUST NOT wait or park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers, on school entrance markings." (Highway Code rule 238, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.)
