



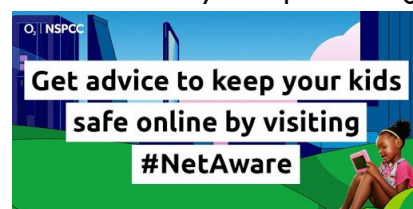
## Autumn Term- Newsletter 10
